Directions to Chubb Lake Bible Camp

If you are travelling from the North

Take highway 97 south 9km past Hixon and turn right on Plett Rd. Then turn left on Quesnel-Hixon Rd (after about 200 metres). Turn right after 6.5km onto Chubb Lake Rd. You will be at the camp in 1.3km (It's past the forestry campground)



If you are travelling from the South

Take highway 97 north 45km past Quesnel and turn left on Morgan Rd. After 3 km turn make a sharp left on Quesnel-Hixon Rd. Then after 4 km turn right onto Chubb Lake Rd. You will be at the camp in 1.3km (It's past the forestry campground)
